2. For an entry to be valid, entrants must be 18 years and over. Entrants must complete the entry form and accept the terms and conditions prior to the commencement of the event. Handicaps will apply as follows: 18 - 30 years of age - starting on 120 metres (Scratch), 30+ years of age - starting on 112 metres, 40+ years of age - starting on 104 metres, 50+ years of age - starting on 96 metres, 60+ years of age - starting on 88 metres, 70+ years of age - starting on 80 metres.
3. Last year's first prize winners will start on their age handicap + an extra marker back.
4. Participants must not be wearing fitted gumboots. A small supply of gumboots are available; however participants will need to notify event organisers.
5. Entrants consent to royalty-free use of their name, result, image, photographs, video and comments in any publications and marketing in relation to this event by event organisers.
6. Entrants accept that participation in this event is at their own risk and they accept that participating in this event may involve real risk of injury or death including but not limited to: over exertion, dehydration and accidents with other participants, spectators or race participants.
7. Entrants declare that they are physically fit and capable of participating in this event. They are not aware of any medical condition or impairment that will prevent participation in this event or will affect their health by participation. If an entrant becomes aware of any such condition or impairment or they are injured or sick prior to the event, they have the opportunity to withdraw. All entrants will provide event organisers details of any medical or other condition that may be relevant should medical treatment be required or may affect their participation in the event.
